





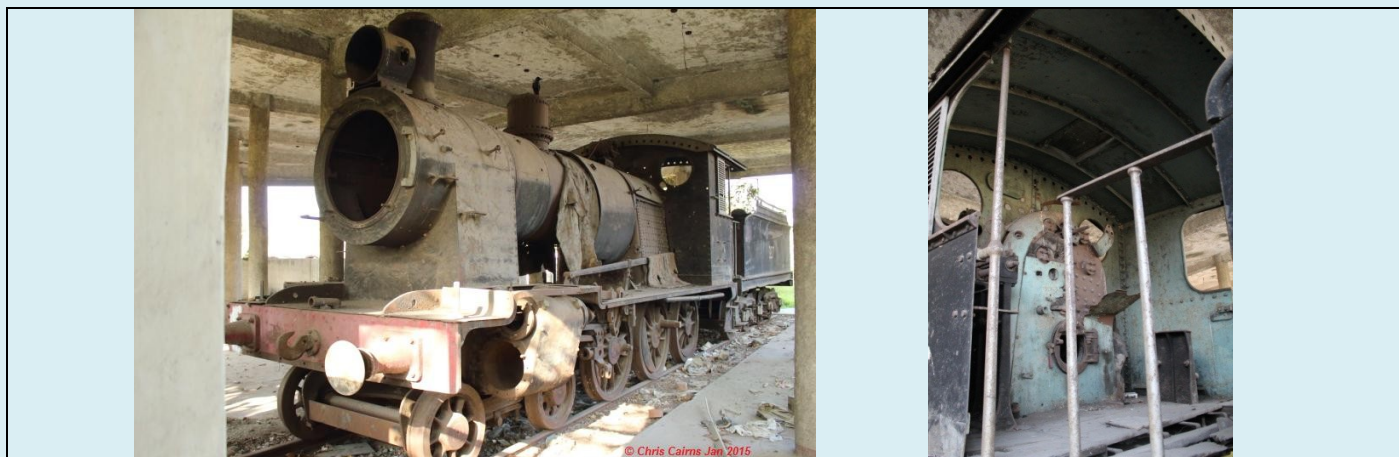


Surviving SLR Broad Gauge Steam Locomotives 5' 6"

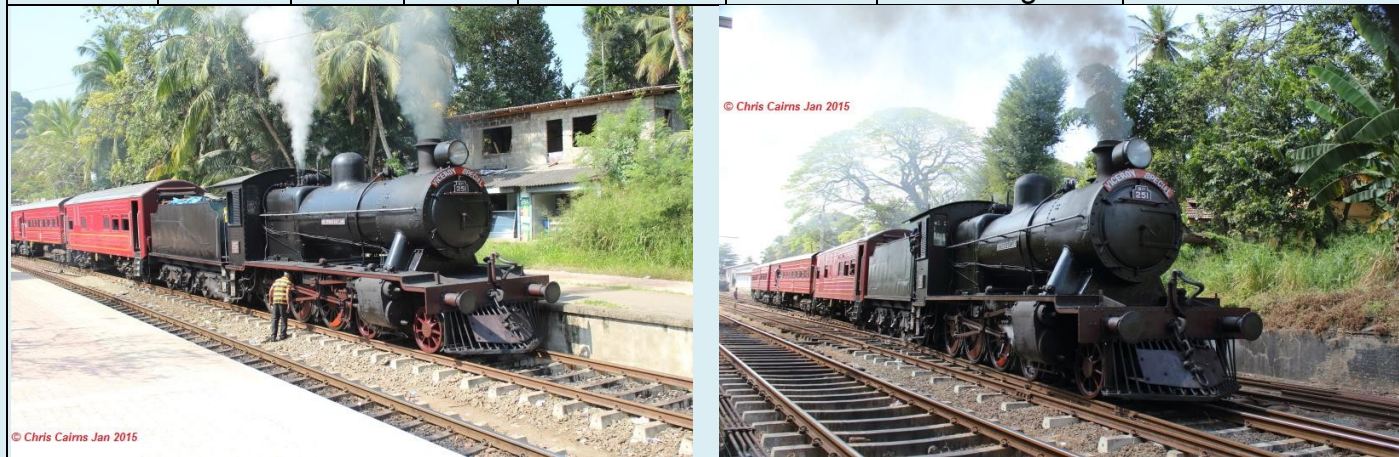

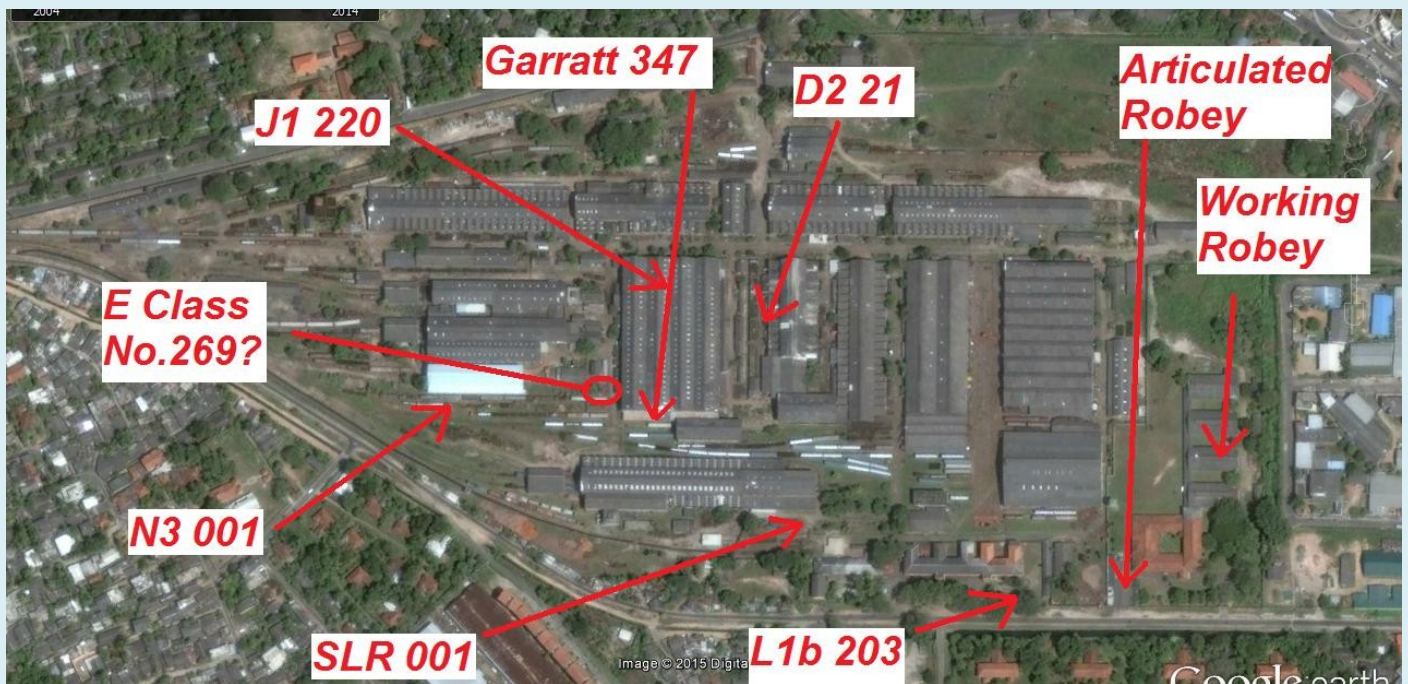

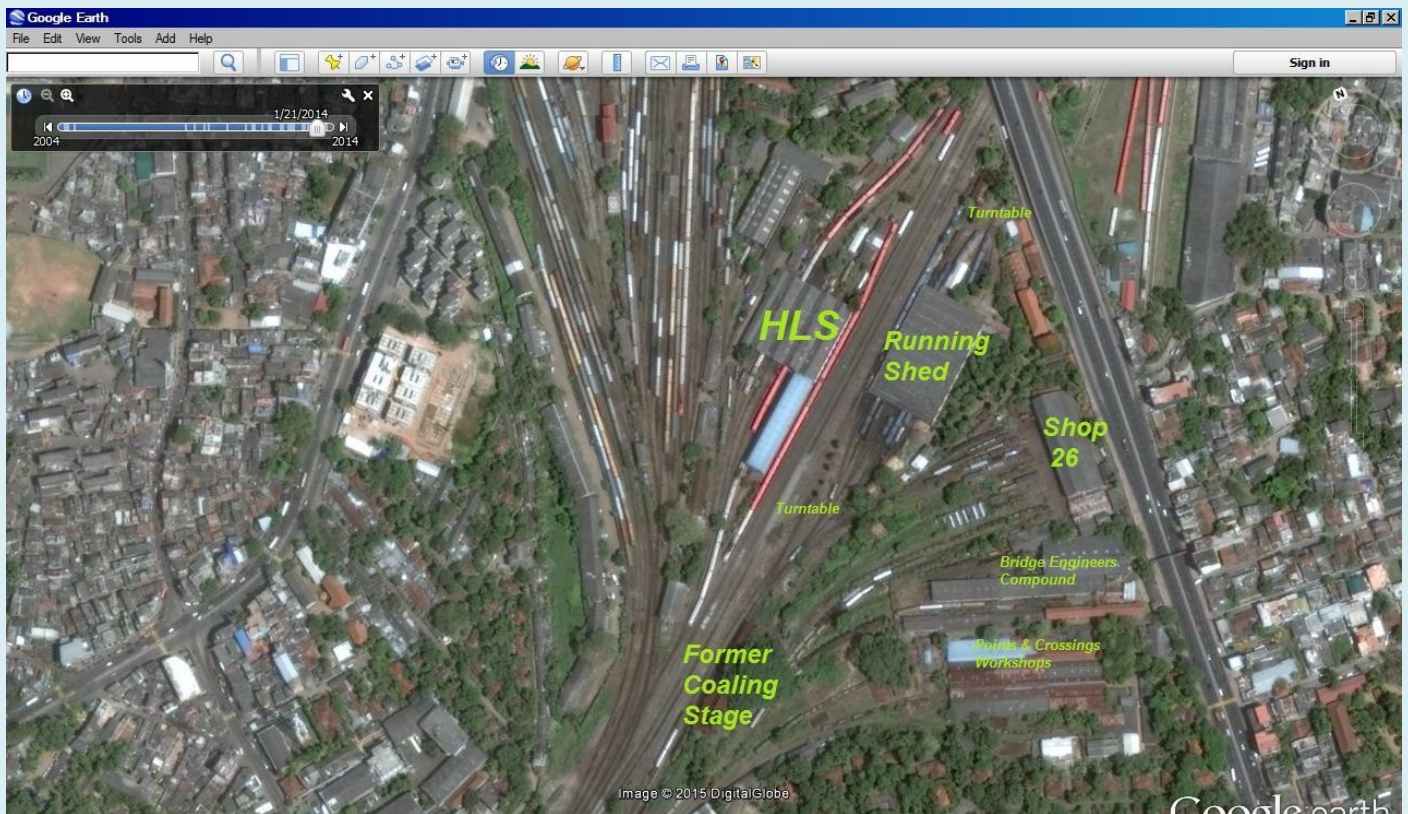
